6:32-6:54 pm: Updates from Ashlie (for Mr. PA)

- Charter buses will be provided to transport from school to prom - \$20 for the transport prom tickets- \$85. 110-120 spots on the buses. Chaperones are welcome
- Ticket for fixing cameras submitted to the district board. No update from the board. Board meeting tomorrow and will be raised there
- Board meeting regarding potential reduction in staff. Encourage parents to attend the board meeting. Positions are eliminated across the board irrespective of individual school requirements. Reduction of staff due to lower enrollment, budget cuts, other changes in administrative policies
- Volunteers needed for SAT tests on March 6. No background check needed. Testing time 8 am to noon. (Time blocks : 1 or 2 hours). Duties: assist the teacher with supplies/accompanying the kids to bathroom
- March 5 - College career fair - state colleges, junior colleges, trade schools - For juniors & seniors during the tutorial. Open for all students during lunch
- March 25 - meeting with the assistant superintendent to discuss funds for school and how they can be used. ST only gets title 2 funds which can only be used for professional development. Title 1 eligibility is decided by the economic status of the attending students. Form filled at the beginning of the school year
- The new building is likely to be opened by the end of March. Punch list of items to be finished before signing off has already been given to the contractors.
