6:35-7:02 pm: Principal's Updates

- Last week's shelter-in-place was challenging because the severity of the situation wasn't clear immediately. An earlier communication from SJPD in the future has been requested
- Mr PA's Secretary will be sending out the updates
- Why did it take so long to update the parents there was not clarity of the threat to the students
- It should have gotten out sooner and will be taken care of the next time
- The message should have been more clear students are safe, parents should not come to school, incident is not inside the school
- A new section added to the school website about Emergency Procedures (the section is in progress)
- Recommendation to share this information with the new students during student orientation
- Auction item pick up can be done at the drop off gate on Snell or Driveways in the parking lot or Bus stop
- Pick up location would be set up before 9 am on Saturday 12/14
- Incoming freshmen orientation will be decided in January middle schools will be visited in the 2nd week of January
- EUSHD can answer the questions about PSAT (As of now, students can register on their own and take the test at an independent venue)
- Number of students registering for SAT is going down as college admissions do not require SAT
- EUSHD needs to be reached out to change the SAT & PSAT test offerings based on
- Email about All clear was not received by all the parents
- Emergency pick up location is not decided way ahead of time to maintain the security of the students
- Substitute teachers were not prepared to handle the situation emergency protocols information will be added in the sub packet
- Taking phones away from students during an emergency is not

needed and will be addressed

- The new building is *almost* ready goal to move it after February. Physics, Science will be moving in the new classrooms
- The color code of the severity of the situation will be updated on the Emergency Procedures page

Code Blue = Shelter in place (eg: police activity near school, chemical spillage near school site)

Code Red = Shooter on campus
